Discover 2 different ways of creating a changing tide drawing


Optical Illusion


1. Draw two circles exactly the same size.

On one circle draw a low tide scene and on the other draw a high tide scene.

Definition:


Tide - The rising and falling water level in a river/sea/ocean.

4. Glue the two circles back-to-back with the straw sandwiched in between.


5. Roll the straw in the palm of your hands to make the optical illusion work.









Lift the flap











3. Glue a thin line across the edge of the high tide piece of paper and stick it to the A4 piece of paper on the horizon line.

4. Lift the flap up to reveal your changing tides scene.
